Writing Your Application

Application is applied by asking questions for understanding. Look at the Scripture you selected and write questions such as...

To whom was the author writing?
What was going on?
Who is the main character in the verse?
The who, what, when, where, why and how, questions.

In order to assist in writing an application, begin with the Scripture and the "key" word. These application questions relate personally to:

Sin

- What sins are pointed out in my life?
- Is there anything I need to forsake?
- Have I confessed these sins to God?

Example

- What examples are there to follow?
- Why?
- What examples are there not to follow?

Challenge

- What are some admonitions I should make on my own?
- How can I follow these admonitions in a concrete way?
- How can I follow these in my relationships, my home; at school; work; with friends, or others?

Action

- Are there errors to avoid?
- What should my actions be?
- Are there any actions which I need to change?

Promise

- What promises can I claim for my life?
- How can I put these promises to work in my life?
- Are there any conditions I must fulfill to claim these promises?
- Are there any specific prayer promises?

Attitude

- What do I learn about bad or good attitudes?
- What are the results of each kind?
- What should my attitude be?

Faith

- What do I learn about personal faith from this passage?
- What do I learn about God, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, and my relationship to them?
- What specific truths do they teach me

These questions are only suggested. Please base your questions for understanding on your personal Bible Study as you continue to grow. Allow the Holy Spirit to lead, guide and direct.
